

**Supplemental  
Transportation Services**  
(For the ODJFS-Administered Waiver Programs)

**Effective July 1, 2006**

Supplemental transportation services enable a consumer to access waiver services and other community resources listed on their All Services Plan. These services are available to individuals on the Ohio Home Care Waiver, Transitions MR/DD Waiver and the Transitions Carve-out Waiver. These services include transferring the consumer from the point of pick-up to the vehicle and from the vehicle to the destination point. Service definitions are included in Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 5101:3-46-04, 5101:3-47-04, and 5101:3-50-04.

- **Agency Supplemental Transportation Services Providers MUST:**
  - Be identified as the provider on the consumer’s All Services Plan;
  - Maintain a current list of drivers and a copy of the valid driver’s license for each driver;
  - Assure that all drivers are age 18 or older;
  - Maintain collision and liability insurance for each vehicle and driver;
  - Obtain and exhibit evidence of a valid motor vehicle inspection from the Ohio Highway Patrol for each vehicle used to transport consumers;
  - Assure that drivers are not the consumer’s legally responsible family member or foster caregiver for the Ohio Home Care Waiver and the Transitions Carve-out waver. For consumers on **Transition MR/DD Waiver**, drivers can not be a member of the consumer’s family or foster caregiver. (OAC 5101:3-45-01)
  
- **Non-Agency Supplemental Transportation Services Providers MUST:**
  - Be age 18 or older and possess a valid driver’s license;
  - Maintain collision and liability insurance for each vehicle used to provide supplemental transportation services;
  - Obtain and exhibit evidence of a valid motor vehicle inspection from the Ohio Highway Patrol for each vehicle used to transport consumers;
  - Maintain collision and liability insurance for each vehicle used to transport consumers;
  - Not be the consumer’s legally responsible family member or foster caregiver as defined in OAC 5101:3-45-01 for the Ohio Home Care Wavier and the Transitions Carve-out Waiver. For consumers on **Transition MR/DD Waiver**, drivers can not be a member of the consumer’s family or foster caregiver as defined in OAC 5101:3-45-01.
  
- **Supplemental Transportation Service Providers MUST:**
  - Maintain documentation on each consumer that includes information outlined in OAC 5101:3-46-04, 5101:3-47-04, and 5101:3-50-04.
  
- **Supplemental Transportation Services providers MUST NOT:**
  - Bill for services in excess of what is approved on the consumer’s All Services Plan.
